## Site-Seeing Suggestions

### **New Mexico State Capital**-490 Old Santa Fe Trail, Santa Fe

New Mexico became America's 47th state on Jan. 6, 1912, signed into statehood by Pres. William Howard Taft. It took more than half a century for New Mexico to achieve statehood. The U.S. government established the Territory of New Mexico in 1850.



### **The Cathedral Basilica of St. Francis of Assisi**-131 Cathedral Place, Santa Fe

The crowning achievement of Archbishop Lamy's church construction in New Mexico, the Saint Francis Cathedral was built between 1869 and 1886 and designed in the French Romanesque Revival style. Although its design contrasts the surrounding adobe buildings, the cathedral remains one of Santa Fe's most celebrated landmarks. **Open Friday 9 to 5pm**

### **San Miguel Chapel**-401 Old Santa Fe Trail, Lower Old Santa Fe Trail, Santa Fe

San Miguel Chapel is the oldest Catholic Church built in the United States part of whose original walls are still standing and which is still used regularly for religious services. It is the centerpiece of El Barrio de Analco National Register Historic District in Santa Fe. Only open on Saturdays [San Miguel Chapel](#)
